RENTAL AGREEMENT

- Extractor and Refractometer rental only available for members of Apalachee Beekeepers Association at the rate of \$10.00/day plus a \$25.00 cleaning deposit per rental.*
- Non-members wishing to rent the extractor have the option of becoming members of our association (\$15 yr.) before renting.*
- Rental term will be from the day of pick-up until the day returned.*
- Extractor must be returned clean. Follow cleaning instructions below. Deposit will be forfeited if extractor is returned unclean.*
- Extractor and Refractometer must be picked up and returned by renter.*
- Request should be made at least 1 day prior to pick-up date.*
- Equipment not returned on time will accrue an additional daily rental charge.*
- If club has to chase down the Extractor and Refractometer, a \$50 charge will be assessed.*
- Renter will be held financially responsible for all damaged and missing equipment.*
- This form also serves as an invoice. Payments should be made according to information on this form. Payment and completed rental form must be received before the equipment can be released.*
- Apalachee Beekeepers Association is not liable for any injuries or damages that occur while equipment is in possession of the renter.*

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS FOR EXTRACTOR

- DO NOT disassemble any component of the extractor to clean.*
- Rinse out the honey and wax – hot water works best.*
- Spray with bleach solution made by diluting one cup of household bleach in one gallon of cool water and add one cup of white vinegar. Let soak for 5 minutes and rinse thoroughly with tap water.*
